

SUMMARY OF MEDICAL GRADUATE TRAINING PERMIT PROCESS

1. Determine whether you qualify

Meet **both** of the following conditions:

1. Within a two-year period immediately preceding initial application for a transitional training permit, was either:

(a) Qualified to submit, and submitted, a valid application to an accredited internship or residency program but was not selected for a position. OR

(b) Selected for a position described in subdivision (a) of this paragraph but ended participation in the program before completion for a reason that would not be considered grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to section 32-1451. **AND**

2. Successfully completed steps one and two of the United States medical licensing examination or equivalent exams.

3. Pays the \$50.00 fee.

2. Submit Application to the Arizona Medical Board (AMB)

The AMB does not have the ability to provide or locate a qualified supervising physician or employment.

3. If Approved by AMB:

- The supervising qualified physician must provide written notice to the AMB prior to supervising the permittee.
- Before employing or contracting with a permittee, an eligible entity **shall notify the department of health services** on a form prescribed by the department, or on an equivalent form from the entity, of all the following information:
 1. The types and extent of medical training the entity plans to provide to the permittee.
 2. The names of the qualified physicians who will supervise the permittee and the types of health care tasks that may be delegated to the permittee by those supervising qualified physicians.
