## SUMMARY OF MEDICAL GRADUATE TRAINING PERMIT PROCESS

## 1. Determine whether you qualify

Meet **both** of the following conditions:

- **1.** Within a two-year period immediately preceding initial application for a transitional training permit, was either:
  - (a) Qualified to submit, and submitted, a valid application to an accredited internship or residency program but was not selected for a position. <u>OR</u>
  - **(b)** Selected for a position described in subdivision (a) of this paragraph but ended participation in the program before completion for a reason that would not be considered grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to section 32-1451. AND
- **2.** Successfully completed steps one and two of the United States medical licensing examination or equivalent exams.
- **3.** Pays the \$50.00 fee.

## 2. Submit Application to the Arizona Medical Board (AMB)

The AMB does not have the ability to provide or locate a qualified supervising physician or employment.

## 3. If Approved by AMB:

- The supervising qualified physician must provide written notice to the AMB prior to supervising the permittee.
- Before employing or contracting with a permittee, an eligible entity shall notify the
  department of health services on a form prescribed by the department, or on an
  equivalent form from the entity, of all the following information:
  - 1. The types and extent of medical training the entity plans to provide to the permittee.
  - **2.** The names of the qualified physicians who will supervise the permittee and the types of health care tasks that may be delegated to the permittee by those supervising qualified physicians.
